

2020 Annual Health Econometrics Workshop TO BE HOSTED VIRTUALLY OCTOBER 1 AND OCTOBER 8-9, 2020

The purpose of this invitational workshop is to provide a forum to discuss the use of econometric and other quantitative methods to address issues in health economics and policy, health services research, and outcomes research.

We invite papers that develop new methods, assess existing methods, or highlight the use of non-proprietary software that address topical issues in health economics, health services and policy. Papers will be chosen for their originality, innovativeness, and rigor.

An hour will be devoted to each paper selected for discussion (approx 4-5). We will have 2 papers on Thursday Oct 1, and 2 papers on Oct. 8. Friday AM Oct 9, we will have a breakout session for econometrics topics germane to Covid-19. A discussant will present the paper, followed by the author's rebuttal and Q&A which will be moderated.

Submitted papers should be unpublished and not accepted for publication at a peer reviewed journal. Those invited to participate in the

workshop will be notified by July 15, 2020. A discussant for each paper will be selected after the author confirms participation.
